Golf Event Booking Terms & Conditions

These conditions apply to the booking of any golf event at Vale Royal Abbey. We have attempted to keep them as simple as possible. Please do not hesitate to contact us if any point is not clear.

1. Provisional Bookings & Confirmation

All bookings are provisional until confirmed by the submission of a fully completed booking form accompanied by the appropriate deposit. Provisional bookings will only be held for 14 days unless alternative arrangements have been agreed. The Club reserves the right to release provisional bookings if a deposit has not been received within the agreed period. No booking is confirmed until the deposit is received in full and a returned written acknowledgement has been issued.

2. Booking Fee

All bookings must be secured with a fully completed booking form submitted to the Club and a booking fee of 10% (unless otherwise agreed in writing) which the Club regrets is not refundable. At the time of confirming your booking, minimum numbers for your event will be agreed.

3. Cancellations

In the event of cancellation, the deposit is forfeited. The following are the maximum charges that will apply in addition to the forfeiting of the booking fee provided.

With 4 weeks notice or less - 100%

The Club will endeavour to replace any cancelled bookings. If successful, this will be reflected in the final cancellation charge.

4. Minimum & Final Numbers

A minimum number of 12 golfers are required. Final numbers must be notified 3 Working Days (Monday-Friday) prior to date of booking and final payment is required on this date too. Failure to notify final numbers will incur charges on the numbers originally specified in the booking or the actual number of guests that attended whichever is the greater. Where there is no minimum number stipulated at the time of booking, numbers may drop by a maximum of 10%. If numbers drop by more than 10% cancellation charges will be calculated in accordance with paragraph 3. Should numbers attending exceed those numbers booked and / or finalised the Club will endeavour to cater for such additional numbers but can not guarantee such. Where numbers are in excess of the booked / final numbers provided, and the Club is able to cater for such, then the actual number attending will be the number for which you will be charged.

5. Liability of the Club

The club accepts no responsibility for loss or damage to any property of the customer or its guests other than such as may be caused as a direct result of any negligent or fraudulent act or omission of the club. Any damage to the building or its contents caused by the customer or its guests is the responsibility of the customer. The customer agrees to pay the Club the full cost of any Club property which is stolen or damaged beyond repair. Where property is damaged yet repairable the customer will pay all costs incurred to rectify the damage. Should the customer wish to fix items to the walls, floors or ceilings, club consent is required in advance.

6. Payment Terms

An invoice for the food content of the event will be submitted to you 7 days prior to the event based on the final numbers provided and the verbal invoice amount communicated. This invoice must be paid in full at least 5 days prior to the event. Any further charges for wine, drinks etc. must be paid in full on the day.

7. Credit Arrangements

Where a credit arrangement has been specifically agreed in writing, terms are strictly payment within 14 days from the date of invoice. We reserve the right to apply an interest charge of 2% per month on outstanding amounts.

8. Tee Reservations

All tee reservations will be from the 1st tee only unless specifically agreed and confirmed in writing by Vale Royal Abbey. Should tee reservations not be adhered to Vale Royal Abbey reserve the right to withdraw permitted usage of the course to those persons not having 'teed off' during the confirmed tee reservation period, in such instances the booked / final number of golfers provided will be charged for. Yellow tees, or red tees for Ladies, shall be used unless otherwise agreed in writing.

9. Course Closure

In the event of closure of the course, e.g. due to inclement weather, no refund of monies will be made but an equivalent day will be arranged on a subsequent date.

10. Winter Golf

There may be occasions during the winter when play will be from mats and to frost holes. Where more than a total of six holes are affected by such conditions a reduction of £10.00 per person will be offered against the green fee element of the package price.

11. Golfing Standard

All golfers within your party are required to be of handicap standard and should bring their handicap certificate with them.

12. Soft Spikes

Vale Royal Abbey is a soft spikes Club. No metal spikes are permitted. Pimpled sole golf shoes are permitted.

13. Dress

Recognised golfing attire must be worn on the course in accordance with the Club's normal rules. Smart casual wear is acceptable throughout the Clubhouse. Jeans, training shoes, track shoes, and collarless T shirts are not permitted. Shirts must be worn inside trousers at all times. Shorts must be tailored and worn with white ankle socks.

14. Changing

All participants are required to change in the changing rooms. Changing of shoes and clothing in the car park is not permitted.

15. Etiquette

The organiser of a golf day is responsible for the behaviour of his / her guests on the day. We do expect the highest standards of golfing etiquette and particular attention is paid to the replacement of divots, repair of pitch marks and smoothing of bunkers. Golfers are also expected to play at a reasonable pace and must observe any instructions which may be given by Vale Royal Abbey personnel.

16. Objections or Queries

Any customer wishing to raise objections or queries concerning their accounts must do so in writing within 7 days of the invoice date. Whereupon any amount not in dispute shall be paid in accordance with the payment terms and any balance immediately upon the amount being agreed between the Club and the customer.
